The Jackson Hole Historical Society and Museum is calling all artists – young and old, professional and amateur – to display your original Jackson Hole art piece in our winter exhibit.

My Jackson Hole History: A Cooperative Community-Curated Exhibit

WHAT

My Jackson Hole History (MJHH) is an educational exhibit driven by community participation. The purpose of the exhibit is to help connect our past and present through storytelling. Each participant is asked to reflect on their favorite part of Jackson and personal history here in the valley. The museum is providing the prompt "My Jackson Hole history is..." to a variety of students and community members, including artists, non-profit organizations, businesses, and government agencies in the valley. There will be artwork by children, the elderly, professional, amateurs, and students; this is a chance for everyone to show their original artwork in a gallery. While the exhibit will be diverse, the theme of Jackson Hole history will be a common theme seen across the walls.

WHY

The JHHSM is dedicated to preserving and sharing the local history of Jackson Hole to help inform and inspire the present and future. The MJHH exhibit encourages community members to think about their own role in Jackson Hole history, connection to place, and legacy. The exhibit will include informal written histories, objects from our collection, and creative pieces from local artists. We hope this exhibit encourages local participation and engagement with the unique character of Jackson Hole.

HOW

Call

An original piece of art work that responds to the prompt, "My Jackson Hole History Is..."

Size & Medium

11"x14" in any medium. 2d and 3d work accepted (3d work not to exceed 12" in any direction). Cardstock available for use at the History Museum, 225 N. Cache, simply stop by to pick up!

Entry Fee

None! Artists can choose to donate the artwork to JHHSM or pick-up their work at the completion of the Exhibit. All artwork will be used for promotional materials throughout the winter exhibit and will potentially be selected for future use if artist permission granted.

Deadline & Delivery

Drop-off artwork at the JHHSM, 225 N Cache St., between 10am - 4pm during the month of November 2018. Submissions will be accepted November 1 - 30 at the Administrative door.

Artist Call FAQs

What are the dates for the Exhibit?

The exhibit will up at the Jackson Hole Historical Society and Museum from December 12, 2018 – March 30, 2019. Artists can either donate their artwork to the JHHSM at the completion of the exhibit or must pick up their artwork by April 15, 2019.

Is there an opening reception?

Yes! There will be an opening reception on December 20th, details to follow.

Do I need to reserve my space?

No, simply submit your piece to the JHHSM between November 1-30 and it will be included in the exhibit. The JHHSM will accept artwork Monday - Friday from 10am - 4pm at the Administrative offices located at 225 N. Cache. Have trouble finding us? Call us at 307-733-2414.

Do I have to hang my artwork myself?

No, JHHSM will install all artwork with small pins or other non-intrusive mechanisms.

Does my art have to be in a frame?

No, all types of pieces will be accepted.

Can I sell my art?

No, the exhibit is purely educational. However, the JHHSM is open to discussing the possibility of selling artwork in the museum gift shop following the exhibit.
