

FAQ's: Summer Camp

At the Jackson Hole Historical Society and Museum

I've never been to the museum! Where do I drop off and pick up my child?

All pick up and drop off will be at our main location at 225 N Cache Street. You can park in the lot behind the museum. Check in will be from 8:30-9:00. And pick up at 3:00.

What do I need to bring to check my child in?

The summer camp photo release form, and waiver is due on the first day of their camp. We will have forms onsite available to sign as well.

What should I pack for my child? Do they need a lunch?

Attire: Make sure they wear comfortable clothes that make it easy to play and have fun! Also, we will be spending time outside so pack a hat and sunscreen too so your child can apply it if needed.

Snacks/Lunch/Water: Please bring a lunch with some afternoon snacks. Please also send a water bottle for your child to stay hydrated.

Can someone else pick up my child?

If your child is being picked up by someone else, they must also show a photo ID and be listed on your release form as an authorized person to pick up your child.

What activities will they be doing?

The week before the camp start you will receive a camp schedule with what activities your child will be doing. The Dude&Dudines camp will be playing cowboy and cowgirl for a week at our on-site "dude ranch" while Architects&Archaeologist camp will learn to dig like a real archaeologist!

Who will be the child's counselors?

Our Museum Education staff will be leading each camp day. We will also have a High School Education Intern helping as well.
